






Where to stay

NH Collection Checkpoint


Some of Berlin's most famous sights such as Checkpoint Charlie, Potsdamer Platz and the Brandenburg Gate are only a few minutes walk away.




Scandic Hotel

A rich breakfast buffet with a large selection of organic products as well as fresh regional and seasonal dishes await you in the hotel restaurant "3rd floor".




25hours Hotel

The Bikini building is home to the 25hours Hotel Bikini Berlin with a direct view to the Zoolohischer Garten in the north and West Berlin's hallmark to the south.

The rooms facing the zoo, as well as the jungle sauna with a view of monkeys and elephants, the restaurant NENI Berlin on the roof, and the Monkey Bar with a spectacular roof terrace all offer an excellent view of the tranquil park at the heart of Berlin.



What to do (Highlights)

Trabi Tour

Drive an iconic East German Trabi Car and experience Berlin up close!

On the traces of the Berlin Wall in 60 minutes!

The tour takes approx. I hours through the capital and as a souvenir the guest will receive a Trabi driving license and a funny group picture.

After the Tour, the guests will go back to the hotel and have time to freshen up in their rooms before we head to the dinner location!





A glass bakery and butchery, a small in-house brewery, a pastry shop and a canteen where you can look over the cooks' shoulders bring food production out of anonymity and back into the urban environment - that is Markthalle 9 in Kreuzberg!

After a short walk from the WALL Museum, the guest will arrive at this cool location for lunch. We will hand them vouchers they can redeem at the food stands of their choice.

Graffiti Workshop at the Berlin Wall

How about a graffiti course in Berlin?

In this street art workshop the guests will learn all about the graffiti culture that makes Berlin a unique city. They will also have the opportunity to spray their own - completely legal - artwork on a remnant of the Berlin Wall!

In the famous Mauerpark in Prenzlauer Berg, the guests will first learn about the amazing culture behind graffiti and then will be taught the basic graffiti techniques and skills.

Afterwards, we'll head to a specially prepared section of the graffiti wall in the park to start spraying!




Sanssouci Palace and Parc

The location of the palace on the famous vineyard terraces and the original room furnishings from the 18th century allow visitors today to immerse themselves in the world of the "philosopher of Sanssouci". The rooms are characterized by elegance and stylish splendor.

Since 1990, Sanssouci with its palaces and extensive palace grounds has been protected by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site and a must-see in the Berlin Region.

The guests will enjoy a 60-Minute guided tour of the famous Castle and can afterwards explore the Garden.



DDR and Soviet Tour of Potsdam

Enjoy a private walk with a real "Potsdamer". Learn more about Potsdam's fascinating Soviet secrets. Hear about the Potsdam Conference of the Allies in the summer of 1945, KGB activities in Soviet Potsdam, life in the Forbidden City, and the world-famous Bridge of Spies.

A deep dive into the world of former East Germany.

This tour can also be offered with E-Bikes.

After the Tour the guest will be driven back to the Hotel and have time to freshen up before the Dinner starts.






With 2,500 square foot taproom, the Dogtap is the ultimate beer oasis, serving freshly brewed beer alongside epic food and experiences like shuffleboards, mini golf, or our desk dog area.

It is not a classic brewery, but convinces with a new, hip concept that combines beer and fun.

Berlin Underground Tour

On this tour, our expert guides will lead you in exploring one of the few remaining bunkers, as it was left after the war. There you will learn more about the life of the average Berlin citizen during the air raids that destroyed up to 80% of the city centre.

Travelling through the twisting passages and rooms, you will also see countless artefacts from the war that have been buried for decades. Additionally, by looking into the development of the city's subway and sewerage systems as well its former pneumatic post, we will provide you with an insight into the 160-year-old underground history of Berlin.



Berliner Bundestag

The last stop of the tour is the iconic Bundestag (the German Parliament).

The guest will have the opportunity to walk up the famous dome.

Afterwards we will host the farewell lunch in the Restaurant located right next to the dome and with a beautiful viel over the city. As a suprise we will place a nicely packed framed group photo, taken during the trip, as a farewell gift on each plate.

The guest will then be driven to the airport.
